

FRANCHISED EQUIPMENT DEALER DRIVER QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

All drivers should meet the following criteria:

- 1. Must have a valid, United States driver's license and have been licensed continuously for at least the past three (3) years.
- 2. Must have the appropriate license (and endorsement, if required) to operate the vehicle(s) which they operate.
- 3. Within the last five years, their MVR should not have any of the following violations:
 - a. No driving under the influence (DUI)
 - b. Driving while impaired (DWI)
 - c. Exceeding a speed limit by more than 20 MPH
 - d. Reckless Driving
 - e. Failing to report an accident
 - f. Filing a false report to the Department of Motor Vehicles or Insurance Company
 - g. Committing a felony with a vehicle
 - h. Fraudulent use of driver's license
 - i. Leaving the scene of an accident
 - j. Passing a school bus
 - k. Participating in illegal racing
 - I. Illegal possession of a controlled substance
 - m. Conviction for negligent homicide
 - n. Vehicular manslaughter
 - o. Aggravated assault with a motor vehicle
 - p. Hit and run incident(s)
- 4. Within the last three years, no more than two (2) total minor moving violations plus at fault accidents. Accidents are considered at-fault unless there is affirmative proof that they were not at fault.
- 5. Within the last three (3) years, no more than one suspension of driving privileges which exceeds sixty (60) days (cumulatively or continuously).
- 6. Must not require a filing (for example, SR-22 or FR-44) in order to maintain driving privileges.
- 7. Any driver over 70 years of age must be required to provide a current medical certificate and other resume information.
- 8. Drivers under the age of 21 years must have a clean driving record and may not take vehicles home.
- 9. Individuals with a CDL (Commercial Drivers License): Drivers must be at least 23 years of age and must have CDL appropriate to heaviest vehicle they will be operating.
